



Formation for the Ministry in Liturgy

Description: We provide support in the formation of new Liturgical Ministers via the fundamental instruction on Liturgy and Eucharist. As an accompaniment to this instruction, pastoral resources are provided for further study at a parish level.



PATHWAYS Liturgy – Training for Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers

This training is divided into two sessions. One for Lectors and the other for Eucharistic Ministers. The goal of this training is to certify Liturgical ministers so that they may serve in this ministry at their parishes.

Course in Liturgy – Ongoing Formation

This course provides basic information on the theological and practical approach to Liturgy and supports the ongoing formation of the Liturgical Ministers at a parish level.



Sharing our Faith – This program provides moments of reflection about the different liturgical feasts throughout the year.
