

Basic Information About Matthew

ca 80-90 C.E.Region around Antioch


- A Greek-speaker, who knew Aramaic or Hebrew or both
- Not an eyewitness of Jesus' ministry
- Drew on Mark and "Q" as well as other oral or written traditions
- Probably a Jewish Christian
 Reproduces about 80% of Mark; about 50% longer than Mark
- Mark






