 - Get direction from the Commission

St. Michael's Dos Palais Clinic Needs a Support Plan

- Won't be able to continue to pay \$49,000 a year within the next 2 years
- Fr. Herald suggested that they let the priest in Haiti know that they cannot keep paying the \$49,000 this will allow them to come up with a plan that parish should be encouraged to contact Fr. Herald to figure out what they can do (Fr. Herald cannot reach out to them)
- Fr. Jonathan suggested contacting Bon Secour corporate budget team to see if they can leverage a grant or something to assist with this
- A separate meeting with St. Michael Haiti Ministers Fr. Herald and the priest of the parish in Haiti is needed

Meeting was taken up by trying to understand the original agreement w/ St. Michael and the Dos Palais Clinic and what exactly is still owed – Caritas was supposed to take over the burden from St. Michael and that didn't happen.
