

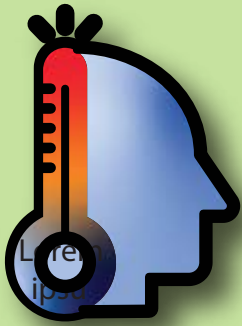

## FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL

If you have a fever or symptoms of COVID-19 you will not be permitted to enter the building. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or more Fahrenheit or having a persistent cough should remain home. Those with compromised immunity, underlying health issues and are age 65+ are encouraged to stay home as well.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

All present at the liturgy, ages 10 and up, and those receiving communion, must wear face coverings. At church, social distancing will be practiced, with a minimum of six feet between people not living in the same household. Please refrain from holding hands during the Lord's Prayer or shaking hands during the Sign of Peace. The faithful are strongly encouraged to receive holy Communion by hand. Those who wish to receive on the tongue are asked to receive Communion after those who have received it by hand.
